Based in Newport, we are seeking Volunteer Counsellors to offer one-to-one time-limited counselling to a minimum 3 adults weekly.

- All trainee applicants must be on a Level 4 course or above, or in their 2nd year or above of a recognised/accredited training institution
- Trainees have preferably had personal therapy and preferably continue with long-term therapy whilst on placement
- Trainees will need to organise and pay for their own Clinical Supervision
